YOU WILL NEED:

SCISSORS

PENCIL

SPLIT PIN (FOR DIAL PADLOCK)

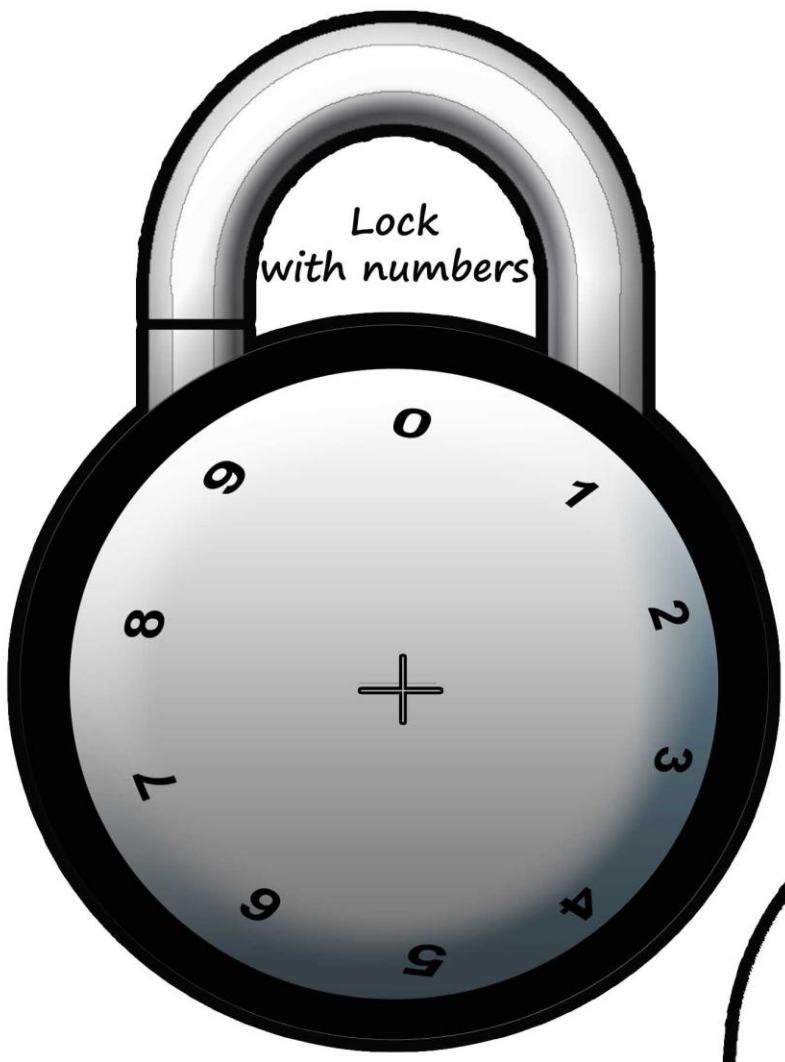
SUGGESTIONS FOR MAKING

THE TEMPLATE CAN BE PRINTED ON PAPER OR CARD. IF YOU ARE COLOURING IN WE SUGGEST YOU DO THIS FIRST BEFORE CUTTING OUT.

ADULT SUPERVISION MAY BE NEEDED FOR CUTTING OUT. PLEASE CUT CAREFULLY AROUND THE THICK BLACK LINES AND AROUND THE INSIDE OF THE LOCK SO IT CAN HANG ON A DOOR HANDLE OR CUPBOARD DOOR.

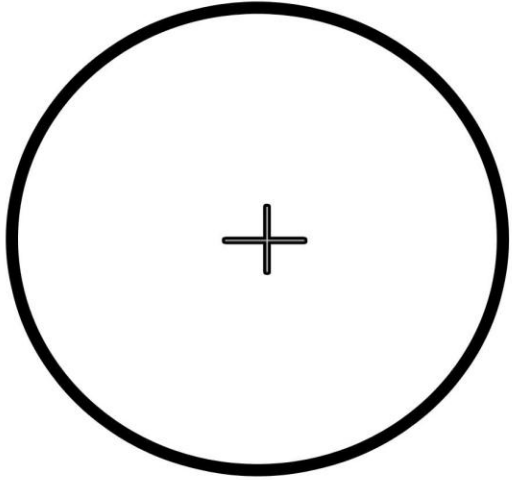
THESE LOCKS WERE CREATED TO ENGAGE CHILDREN (and big kids) IN CREATIVE THINKING AND SOLVING THE PROBLEM NOT TO BE USED AS REAL LOCKS. THE PADLOCKS WITH WHITE BOXES CAN BE USED TO ADD CLUES, (maybe where to find the answer.) ANSWERS CAN BE WRITTEN ON THE LOCK OR TOLD TO THE GAMES MASTER WHO CAN CONFIRM THEY CAN REMOVE THE LOCK AND OPEN THE DOOR/ CUPBOARD/ BOX TO LEAD TO THE NEXT ADVENTURE.

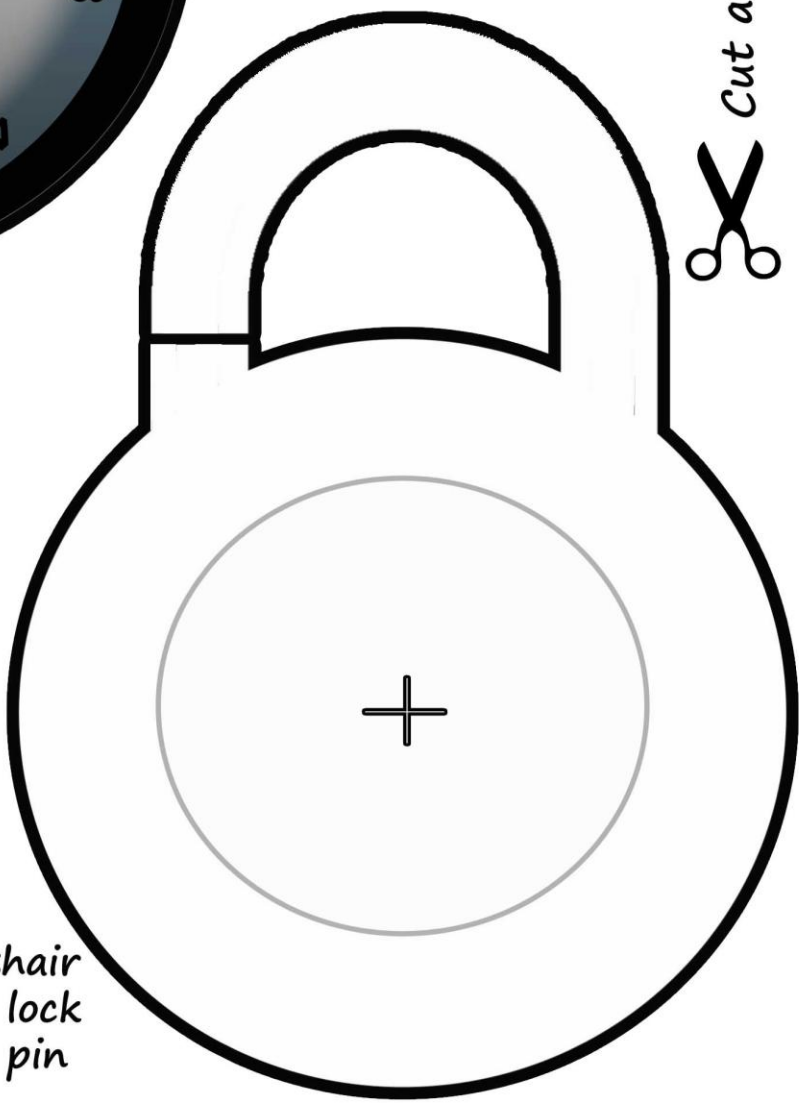


Inside dial

Cut around the thick black lines 



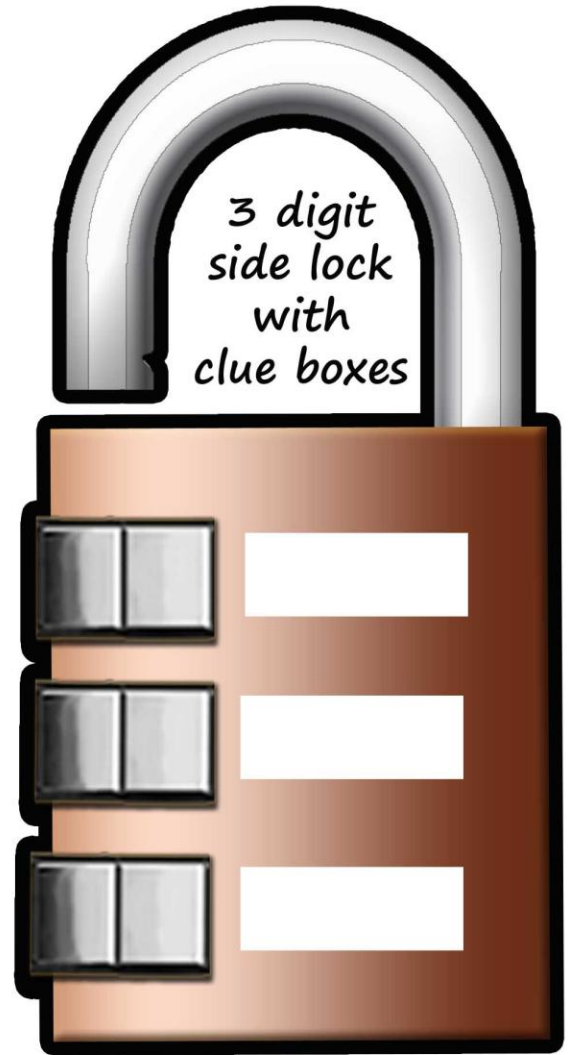
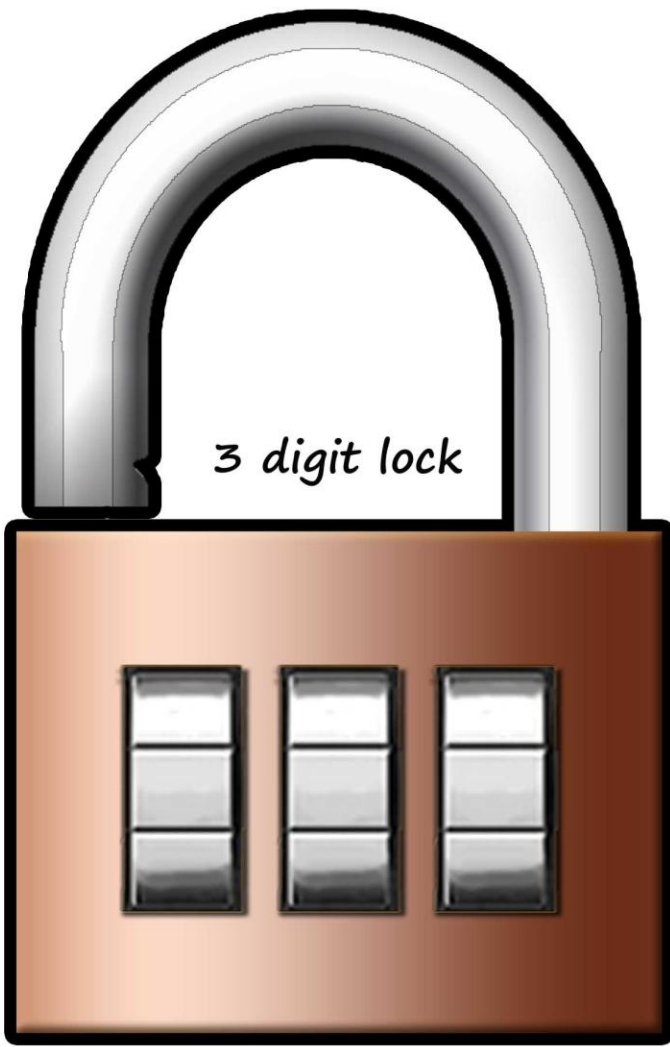
Colour me in
